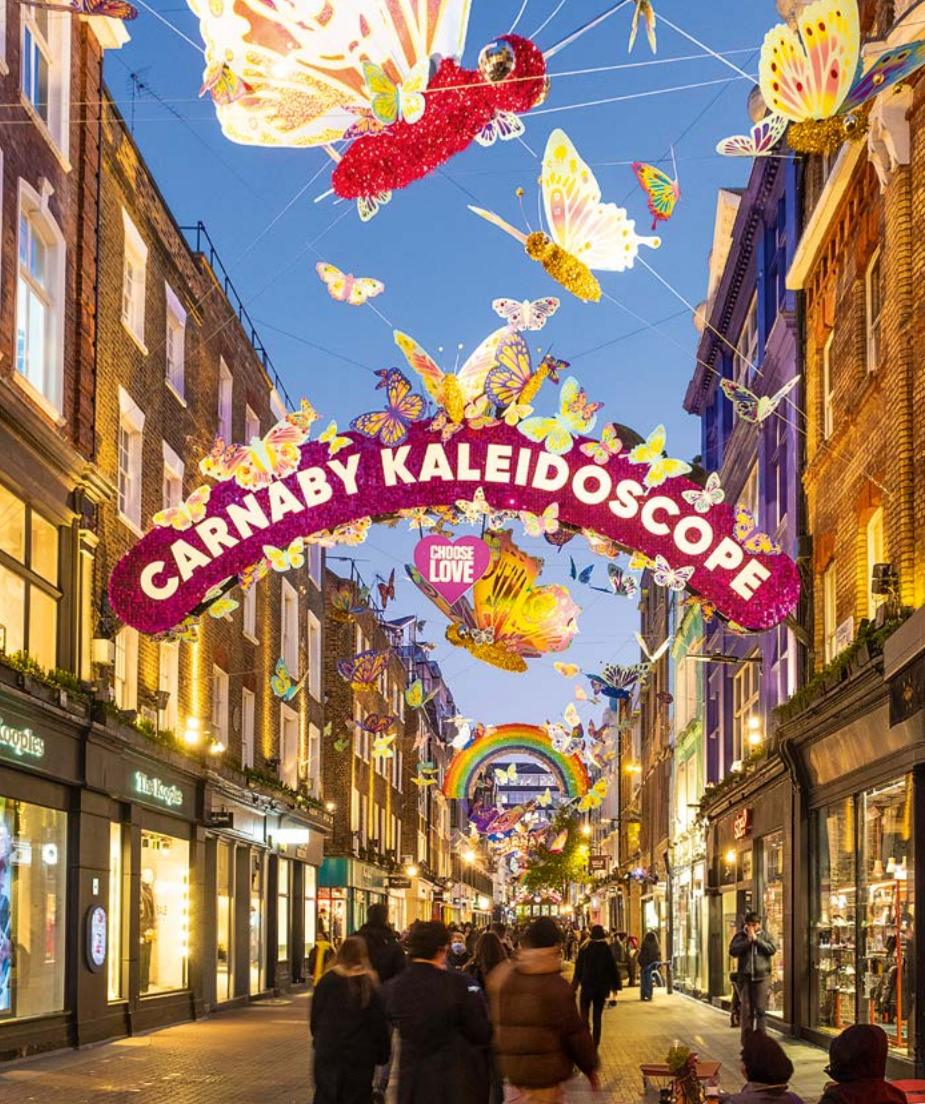

Originally installed in Parliament Square in 1865, the ornate Buxton Memorial Fountain, designed by Samuel Sander Teulon, was moved to Victoria Tower Gardens in Westminster in 1957 and restored as a drinking fountain in 2007 for the 200th anniversary of the Abolition of Slavery Act. The memorial commemorates the work of 19th-century anti-slavery campaigner and MP, Sir Thomas Fowell Buxton.

Arguably the defining landmark of London, Tower Bridge has spanned the River Thames since its completion in 1894, when it was the largest 'bascule' (meaning 'seesaw') bridge ever built. Originally the metalwork was chocolate brown colour but it was given a fresh lick of paint in red, white and blue to celebrate Queen Elizabeth II's Silver Jubilee in 1977.
